



GENERAL

1. Only one Project 25 team per school, church, local club, etc. One team is no more than 10 students and 1-2 adult overseer(s). Consider combining efforts with other clubs and/or teams at your school. Collaboration and cooperation are strongly encouraged.
2. Each Project 25 team must be registered by an adult overseer (teacher, coach, mentor, program director, etc.) by September 21, 2018. Regular check-in sessions with Young Life will be required to assure all teams have access to Young Life support and resources.
3. Only the first 20 teams registered and meeting all criteria will automatically receive a \$100 mini grant from Young Life. After that, Young Life may provide seed money/ funding as funds are available; otherwise, teams will be responsible for securing their own \$100 seed funding.
4. All team project deliverables must be submitted by November 24th, 2018, as per detailed instructions to be announced. A 90 second video documenting the team's project will be submitted to Young Life, along with any other requested documentation. Failure to meet all requirements on time will result in ineligibility for awards and prizes.
5. Each project team is required to attend Celebration of Awards on Wednesday, December 8th, 2018, 5:30pm-7:30pm (location TBD) to receive awards and prizes.
6. Projects will be judged according to: (1) creativity, (2) number of students involved, (3) depth and breadth of impact, (4) sustainability of impact, (5) money raised. More detailed criteria will be provided during project development.
7. The team with the highest (weighted) score of unique views, follows, and "Likes" on YouTube and other social media will win "The Viral Award." The team who brings the most people Celebration of Awards will win "The Mob Award."

ADULT OVERSEERS COMMIT TO:

1. Facilitate brainstorm sessions, connect team members with resources, individuals, etc., as appropriate; arrange for team members to attend required Young Life online check-in meetings.
2. Use Young Life as a resource and support – team successes are everyone's success!
3. Ensure service projects get completed.
4. Ensure project videos and other deliverables are submitted as required, on time.
5. Ensure project team members attend campus awards.

STUDENT PROJECT TEAM MEMBERS COMMIT TO:

1. Build a following, both in the community and in social media.
2. Complete a project and submit a video and other documentation as instructed, on time.
3. Attend the campus awards in full force with your team-mates and supporters.
